

2018-2019 WCSD Transportation News

Welcome to the 2018-2019 school year! With the start of school right around the corner, I would like to share some transportation information and opportunities available to Wolverine students and families.

1. Yellow postcards were mailed home yesterday. On the postcard you will see a bus number, animal and approximate pick-up and drop-off times. Please provide drivers with a 5-minute window for arriving, and ensure your child(ren) is/are outside waiting in a safe, supervised location.
2. If there are changes needed, please communicate with the appropriate school. It is extremely important we have your accurate address and telephone number in our system for safety purposes. Be very clear with what your needs are regarding transportation or your plans for after-school. All children at Lincoln and Elm Street that ride a bus, will only be released from a bus when an adult is present. If no adult is present, the drivers of our school buses will keep the child safely onboard and alert the school for guidance. If a sibling will be responsible for an elementary child, a release must be filled out. Bus drivers have the forms, and will follow the directions once it is returned.

 - e. Transportation – 565-8114
3. Late Runs are available, Monday – Thursday beginning the first day of school. These runs are designed to help families reduce the amount of driving that is needed when children are involved in after-school activities. Therefore, we will provide transportation to students that stay after school for clubs, activities, sports, etc. in grades 7-12. Students that ride the late bus will be dropped at one of the following locations to walk home or meet their parents:
 - a. Chemung Elementary School @5:45pm
 - b. Lockwood Fire Station @6:05pm
 - c. Stateline Auto @6:15pm (by Talmadge Hill and 17C)
4. There will be several new AM pick-up locations for students and families that live within the walk-zone. Students can be picked up and transported to all campuses on a daily basis for the entire year. At this time a PM run is not available. If interested, please report to one of the following locations:
 - a. Lincoln Street Elementary Bus Loop @ 7:00am
 - b. The Waverly Glen Tennis Courts @ 7:10am
 - c. Waverly Public Library at 7:20am
 - d. Public Parking Lot of Broad Street (near Rynones) at 7:25am
