**PreK is the place to be!!**

**What is the WCSD 4-Year Old Pre-K program?**

The district sponsors a Pre-K program for children who are four years old by December 1. The program is offered five days a week, Monday through Friday, when school is in session. The sessions are full day and run according to the school calendar. The session runs from 7:55 until 2:30.

**How much do I pay for the Pre-K program?**

There is no fee for participation in the Four Year Old Pre-K or Three Year Old Pre-K program.

**Do I have to meet income guidelines to send my child to Pre-K?**

No. There are no income guidelines for the Pre-K program.

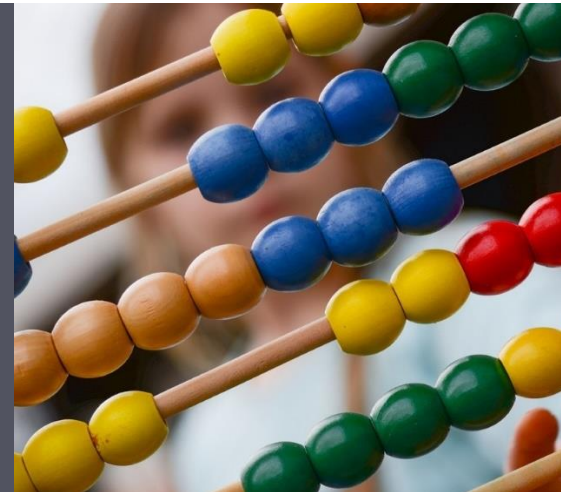
**Does the school provide transportation?**

Busing may be provided for those children age four who live outside of the walking zone to Lincoln school and that are on a school bus route. Otherwise, parents are responsible for transportation to and from school. Parents of children in the three-year-old Pre-Kindergarten program will also be responsible for transportation of their children.



**What is the WCSD 3-Year Old Pre-K program?**

The district sponsors a Pre-K program for children who are three years old by December 1. The program is offered five days a week, Monday through Friday, when school is in session. The sessions are 6 hours long and run from 8:30 – 2:30.

**How old does my child have to be to attend the program?**

Your child must be four years old on or before December 1 to attend the 4PK Program or three years old before December 1<sup>st</sup> to attend the 3PK Program. Children who will be five on or before December 1 are considered to be of school age and are not eligible to attend Pre-K.
