The Summer Meal Pack Program starts on
June 30th and ends on August 11th. A five-day supply of
food will be delivered every Wednesday morning.

June 15th is the last day for WAVE families
to receive weekly meals.

Families need to be enrolled by June 25th to receive
weekly summer meals starting on June 30th.
